

RUTHIN TOWN COUNCIL

The Ruthin Good Citizen of the Year Award / The Ruthin Young Person of the Year Award

Criteria

- i) No serving Town Councillor or Officer may nominate or receive the award.
- ii) The award can only be given to individual **residents of Ruthin**.
- iii) The nominator and seconder must not be a partner or relative of the candidate.
- iv) The candidate must be nominated for voluntary work in the town.
- v) The candidate must have made a significant contribution to the quality of life of Ruthin.
- vi) Nomination forms (available from the Town Council office or on the website) to be received in the Town Council office by **31 March 2017**.
- vii) The nominator or seconder may be required to attend a meeting of the Good Citizen Award Committee to speak on behalf of their candidate, if necessary.
- viii) A panel comprising the members of the Good Citizen Award Committee will then make a recommendation to the next Town Council Meeting.
- ix) There will be no limit to the number of awards made but it is not compulsory to make an award.
- x) The award will comprise a framed A4 Certificate on high quality paper and £100 towards the citizen's chosen Ruthin group / project / cause / charity.
- xi) The awards will be presented at the Annual Town Council Meeting in May.
