

Minutes of the meeting of the **Amenities Committee** held at the

82. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

There were no apologies for absence.

83. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

There were no declarations of interest.

84. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

RESOLVED: *that the minutes of the meeting held on 9 April 2018 be confirmed as a correct record.*

85. MATTERS ARISING

Reference was made to the concrete blocks in Park Road car park, that they had worked to resolve the problem. It was proposed that Ruthin Town Council should pay for plants such as shrubs to be put in the planters.

RESOLVED: *to make arrangement for plants to be placed in the planter and watering arrangements.*

86. PRICES FOR WATERING THE HANGING BASKETS 2018-2020

Two quotations were submitted for watering the hanging baskets for the three year period 2018-2020.

RESOLVED: *to award the contract to J & C Brimble for £3,411.00 in 2018, £3,481.74 in 2019 and £3,547.77 in 2020.*

87. LIGHTING THE WAR MEMORIAL

The Clerk explained that no response had been received from the two companies she had contacted. Councillor Gavin Harris offered to buy one of the lights himself in order to test the strength and suitability of the light emitted.

RESOLVED: *to accept Councillor Harris' offer.*

88. FFORDD GLASDIR SIGNS

A quotation was received from Denbighshire County Council noting that four signs are required at a cost of £882.16 (exclusive VAT). It was noted that enquiries were required regarding who would be responsible for the signs once they are erected.

RESOLVED: *to proceed with ordering the signs and arranging for Denbighshire County Council to erect them.*
